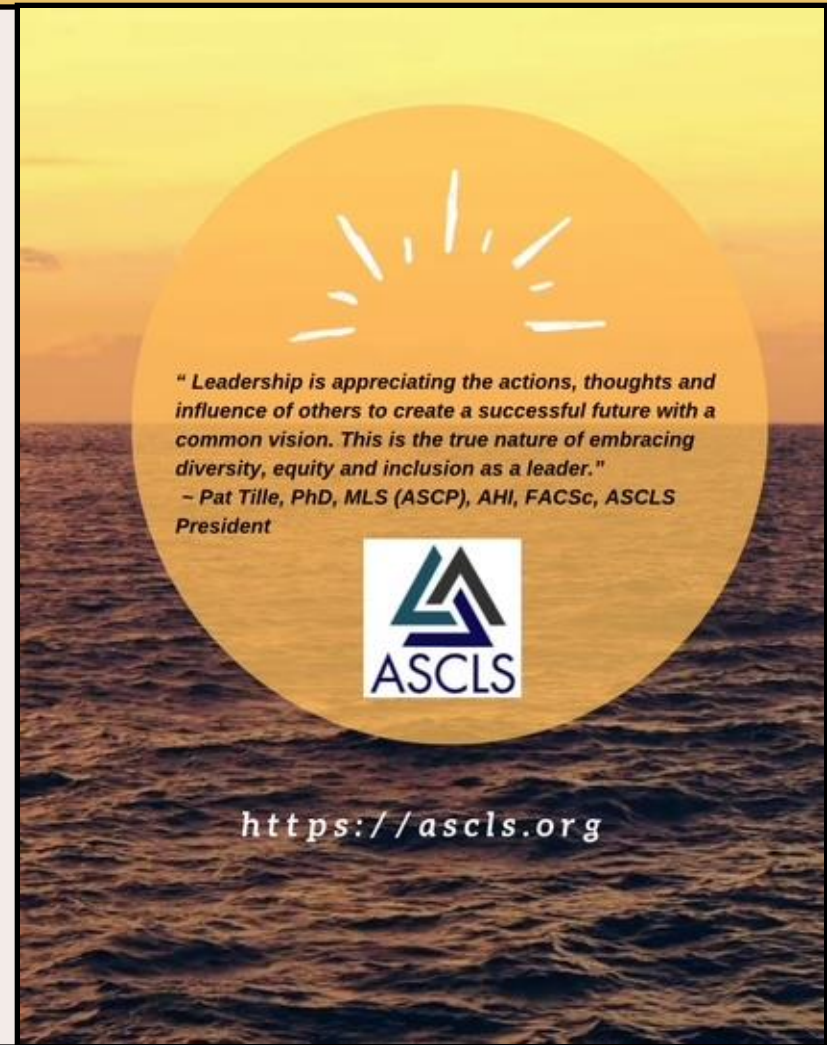

There are many instructional videos on CONNECT. Hopefully, through this PowerPoint you will be able to locate the resources you need.



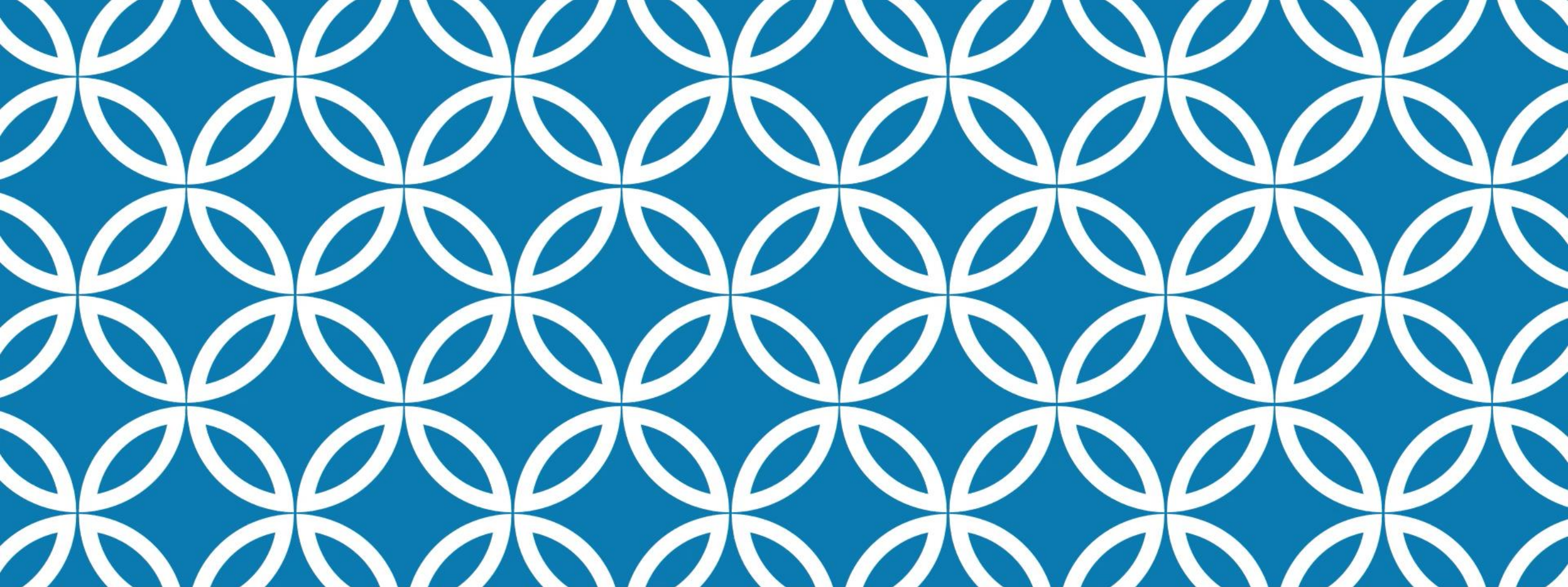

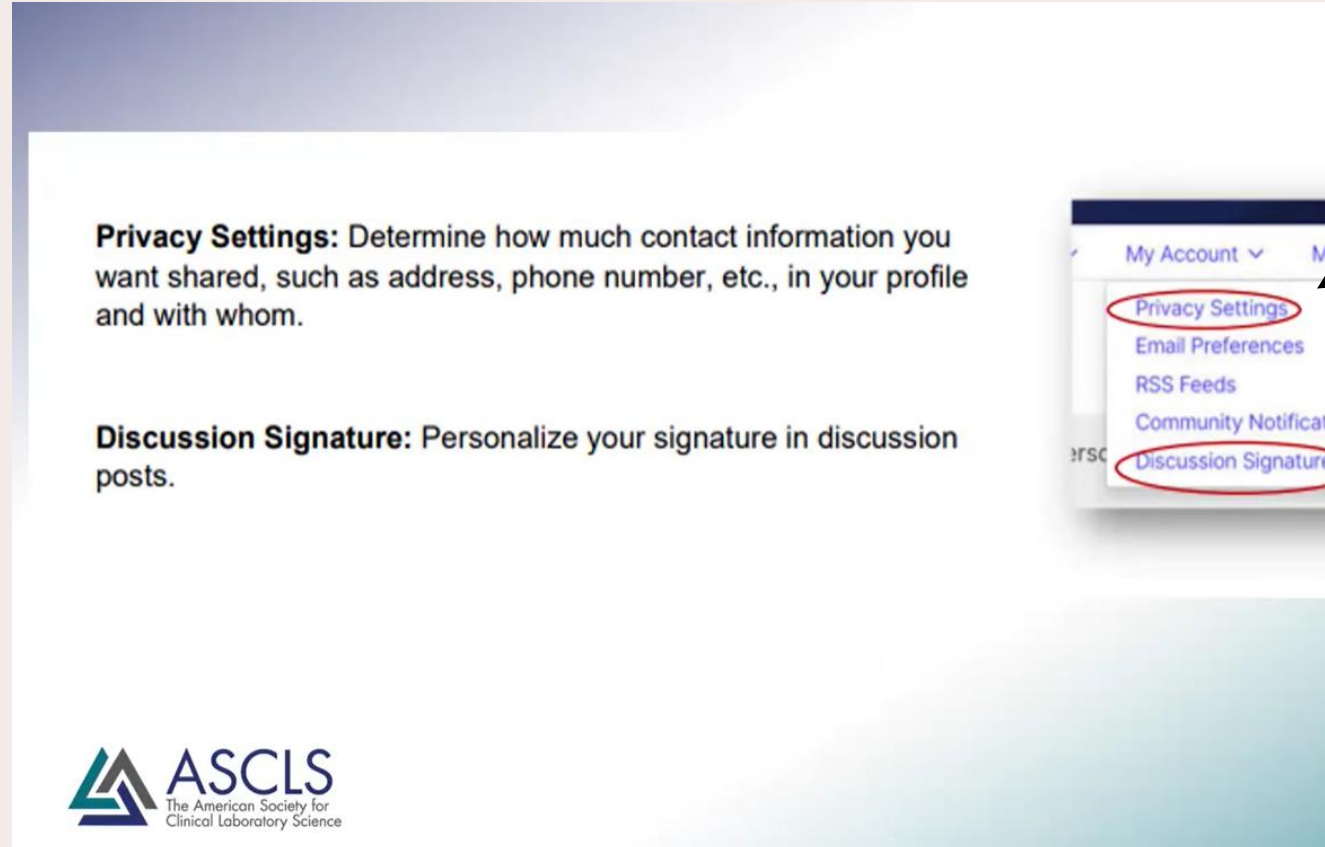

After making an account, you might want to review your privacy setting. It is also nice to have a personalized signature so you don't have to type your name and accolades every time.



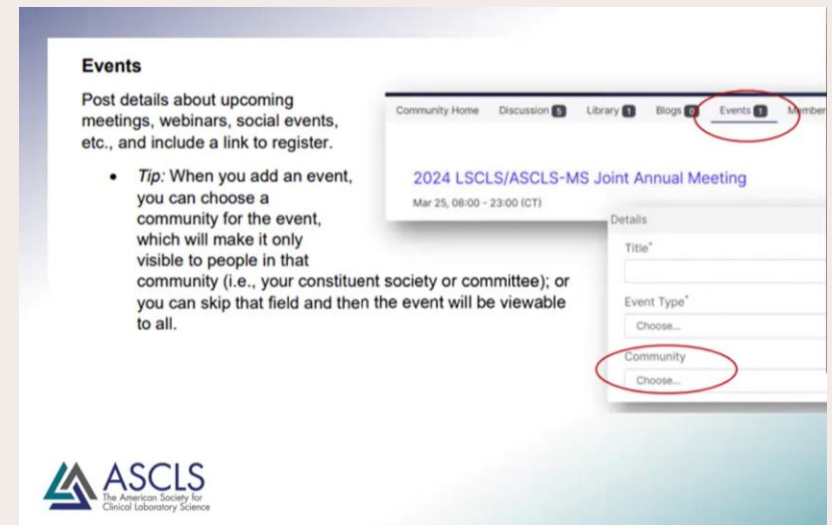
GO to the My Account tab, select dropdown arrow.

Working on something...but not finished yet. CONNCT will save it under My Contributions. You can go to: Profile → My Contributions → My List



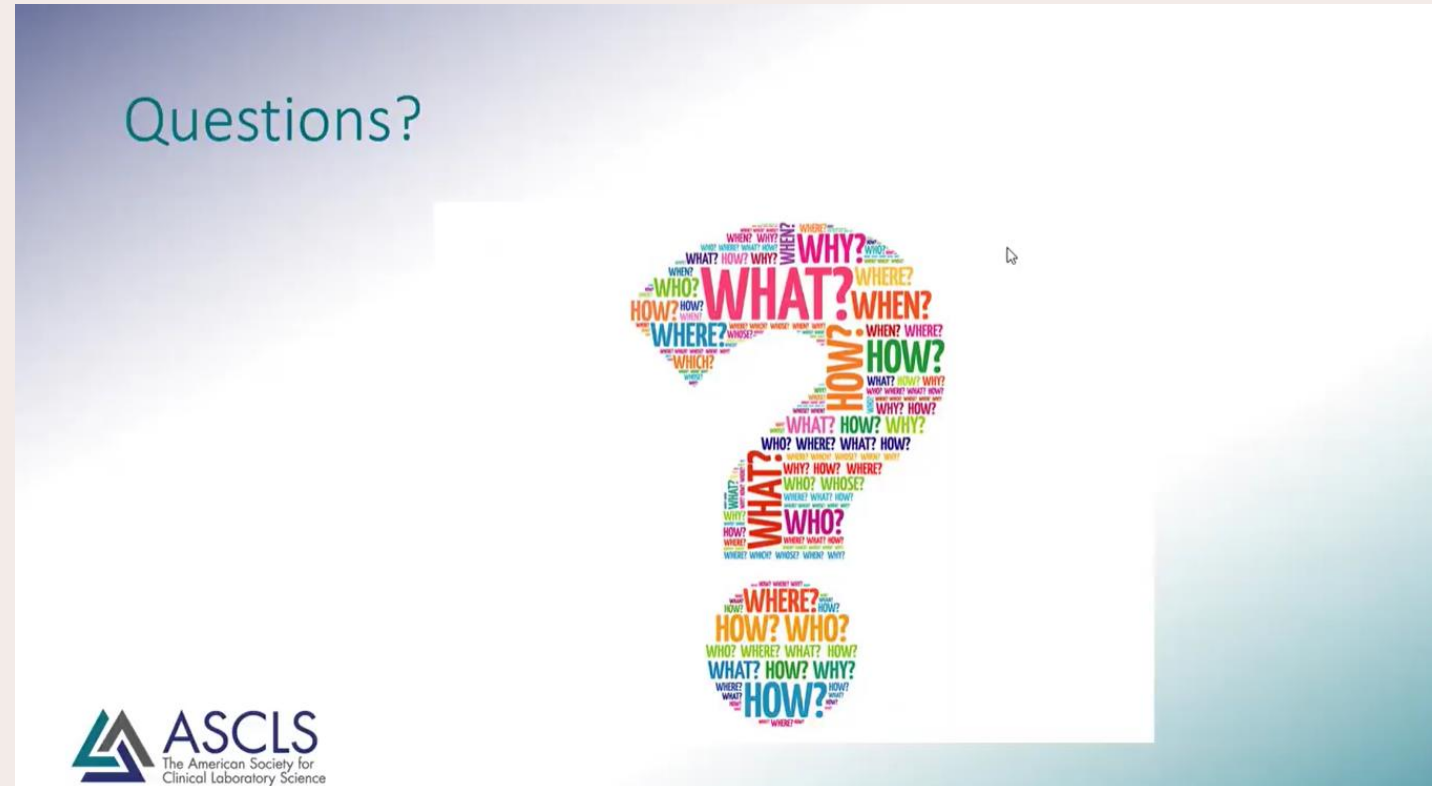

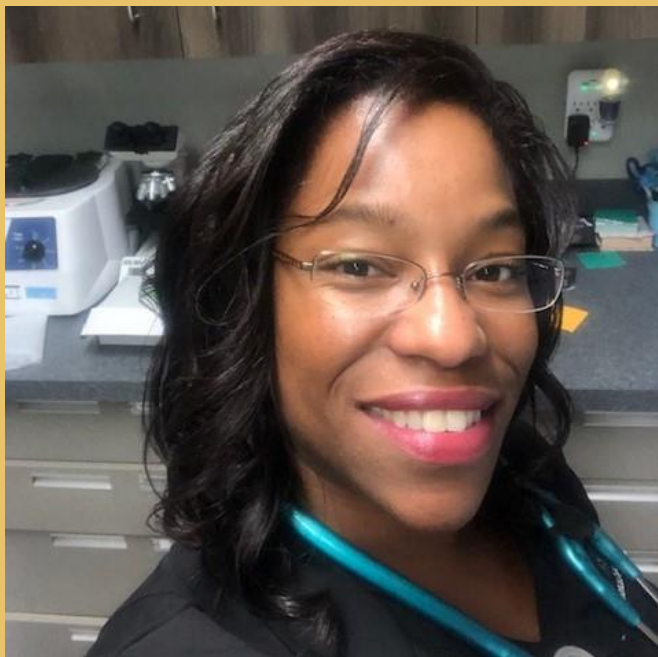
